Work composed of minimum 50%  
 Clay is eligible.  
**Please pack artwork CAREFULLY!**  
**Pieces that arrive damaged will NOT be returned!**  
**The artist will be notified!**

**Rules:** All artists, including those outside the United States, are eligible to submit up till two works per entry. The entry fee is \$30. Each work must be able to fit into a Large Orton Cone Box (3"x3"x6"), but does not have to be mailed in a cone box. A work tag must be securely attached to each work for identification. **All forms must be filled out! ENTRIES SUBMITTED FOR JUDGING MUST BE FOR SALE** and may be sold even if not accepted into the show. No single work may exceed **\$150** in value. A 10% commission will cover the transaction. All works must be original and not have been submitted to a previous Cone Box competition. Accepted work must be available for the two year traveling exhibit and photographic reproduction, as well as be in compliance with the rules.

**Shipping:** Entries should be sent to: 2008 International Cone Box Show, Baker University, 618 Eights Street, Baldwin City, Kansas 66006-0065 USA. Pieces not sold will be returned by UPS or First Class Mail. Return postage is part of the entry fee.

**Entry Fee:** The non-refundable entry fee is \$30 (U.S.A.), which includes the return shipping of the work(s). Check should be made payable to: *2008 International Cone Box Show*. Check and forms must accompany entries.

**Awards:** Up to seventeen \$200 Purchase Awards and three \$250 Juror's Choice Awards will be distributed at the time of selection.
